

**Every Dollar Makes a Difference, Different Dollar Amounts Enable Different Levels of Service**

**\$5 per pay period provides . . .**

- 12 kids with oral health kits, which include a toothbrush, toothpaste, floss, mouthwash and a toy.
- Food pantry services to a family for a month.
- One grant to need-based schools to bring 10 children to the local museum to learn how World War I continues to affect us to this very day.
- 10 job seekers obtain necessary ID for a job or provide 2 job seekers a month with bus passes so they can reach their job interviews
- 30 elementary school students with trained volunteer tutors to help with reading and math.
- 25 children with bilingual beginning-to-read books to build early literacy skills
- Seven 30-minute appointments for health assessment and counseling for individuals facing physical, developmental or mental health challenges.
- 2.5 acres of unprotected tropical rainforest which assures protection of the natural areas vital to our climate and diverse species.
- 2.5 hours of expert training for a citizen's group interested in preserving natural areas in their communities

**...that's \$130 a year.**

**\$10 per pay period provides . . .**

- 15 individuals the ability to participate in a local 12-week family education program.
- Service to alter five dogs/cats, perform 21 vaccinations or alter and vaccinate 10 free-roaming cats.
- Fans to 13 senior citizens during the summer's heat
- Two months of meals for a homebound person.
- Five wigs for children with cancer undergoing chemotherapy.
- Two nights of shelter for a troubled or neglected youth.
- After school care (food, health, recreation, and homework help) for one child for a year.
- Clothing, shoes and a winter coat for one individual who has lost everything in a home fire.
- Temporary shelter for a family of four for three nights following a disaster, or shelter for 10 people for one night.
- Three bowling trips for seniors.
- Gas or power service for an elderly or disabled person who has been threatened with a utilities termination notice.

**. . . that's \$260 a year.**

**20 per pay period provides . . .**

- Four days of care for a terminally ill individual.
- Baby formula for over 100 low-income infants (2 each week).
- A full year of scouting for four girls.
- Ten weeks of work training.
- Two months of preschool for a child at risk of falling through the cracks.
- Funding for daily radio legislative updates, during the legislative session and monthly for interim committees.
- Two lightweight wheelchairs for individuals who is physically challenged.
- Posters and other educational materials to inform national park visitors about steps they can take to help prevent increased air pollution in their parks
- Allows 10 people being treated for mental illness to attend recovery classes that provide education, peer support, and healing strategies.
